

Identifying the Parts of a Box Traceability Code

A traceability or Box Traceability code contains 9 [NINE] or more digits and here is an example:
<33 2 03 633 1>

- The first 2 digits from the start of the code, in this example <33> represent the week number.
- The third digit from the start of the code, in this example <2> represents the day of the week, where 1 is Sunday, 2 is Monday, 3 is Tuesday, 4 is Wednesday, 5 is Thursday and 6 is Friday and Saturday is 7.
- The fourth and fifth digits from the start of the code, in our example <03> represents the Farm reference/number
- The sixth, seventh & eighth digits from the start of the code, in this example <633> represents the “Area code”
