<b>WASH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assess risks/weaknesses of WASH infrastructure</li> <li>• Improve infrastructure</li> <li>• Protect water sources</li> <li>• Reduce dependence from disaster-prone services</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepare for changes in water quality</li> <li>• Install water supply at identified evacuation points</li> <li>• Raise awareness on hygiene promotion and water borne diseases</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use qualitative structures and resistant materials</li> <li>• Integrate awareness-raising and training activities in humanitarian response</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Repair structures considering local capacities</li> <li>• "Build Back Better", ensuring increased disaster resistance and easy maintenance</li> </ul>
<b>Food Security and Nutrition</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promote crop/livelihood diversification, strengthening existing livelihood</li> <li>• Improve post-harvest management</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stockpile key resources (e.g. seeds, fertilisers, vaccines)</li> <li>• Support food/livestock related contingency and emergency response planning</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure that interventions strengthen markets and does not bypass them</li> <li>• Identify alternative food sources</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promote risk-sensitive approaches towards rehabilitation of livelihoods</li> <li>• Contribute to repair of critical infrastructure</li> </ul>
<b>Shelter and Settlement</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support establishment and reinforcement of building codes</li> <li>• Retrofit potentially at-risk structures</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stockpile shelter-equipment and pre-qualify suppliers</li> <li>• Identify shelter concepts and sources of material</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support access to safe, secure and dignified sheltering</li> <li>• Provide technical trainings on safer shelter construction</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select safe construction sites</li> <li>• Train local builders in safe construction techniques</li> </ul>
<b>Health</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use education to build a culture of health</li> <li>• Ensure that safe hospitals and other health facilities continue to function post disaster</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stockpile essential drugs</li> <li>• Predefine processes and responsibilities (e.g. referral systems)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mainstream infection prevention and control (IPC) in emergency health services</li> <li>• Select accessible and safe settings for provision of emergency health services</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Re-construct hospitals and other health facilities considering risk sensitive setting, design and construction in compliance with building codes.</li> </ul>
